# DEEP WOODS ESTATE SHIRAZ ET AL. 2014



### Wine Introduction

The fruit for this not-quite southern Rhône blend was sourced from various mesoclimates throughout the Walcliffe area of the Margaret River wine region. This wine is made predominantly from Shiraz, punctuated with hits of Malbec and Grenache.

## **Tasting Notes**

Loaded with primary fruit aromas of blueberries, plums and raspberry pastilles, the wine has an alluring charm with liquorice and savoury spice notes adding intrigue. The palate exhibits juicy dark plum and sweet, red berry flavours with underlying hints of white pepper. Whilst the palate is well-supported by seasoned French oak, the tannins are soft, round and very fleshy.

## Winemaker Vintage Notes

The 2014 harvest in Margaret River continued a run of excellent vintages.

### Winemaker Vinification Notes

The ferments were managed with a combination of plunging and pump overs. Some batches were basket pressed and then transferred to large seasoned oak barrels for maturation over 12–15 months.
