

CANTINA VALLE ISARCO CLASSIC PINOT NERO/ BLAUBURGUNDER 2016



Wine Introduction

Pinot Nero is a wine made of a variety of noble origins: from Burgundy in France, it was brought to South Tyrol about 100 years ago. The warm hillsides around Campodazzo, in the lower Valle Isarco, provide the ideal conditions for the growing of this acclaimed variety, giving the wine the archetypal expressiveness that has made it one of the most refined reds.

Tasting Notes

This bright, ruby red is intense on the nose, beautifully structured with well-balanced, velvety tannins. It is very dry, with a pleasant acidulous note.

Winemaker Vintage Notes

2016 - A fairly warm season was followed by an autumn with the ideal temperature fluctuations between day and night to develop intense aromas and the optimal ripeness of the grapes. Variety after variety could be harvested at just the right moment. The 2016 wines of the Isarco Valley present themselves without exception as very characteristic of their variety, with prominent fruity tones and with great elegance.

Winemaker Vinification Notes

Traditional maceration on the skins in temperature-controlled conditions in steel vats is followed by malolactic fermentation and ageing on fine lees in large wooden barrels.
