

CANTINA VALLE ISARCO CLASSIC PINOT NERO/ BLAUBURGUNDER 2017



Wine Introduction

Pinot Nero is a wine made of a variety of noble origins: from Burgundy in France, it was brought to South Tyrol about 100 years ago. The warm hillsides around Campodazzo, in the lower Valle Isarco, provide the ideal conditions for the growing of this acclaimed variety, giving the wine the archetypal expressiveness that has made it one of the most refined reds.

Tasting Notes

This bright, ruby red is intense on the nose, beautifully structured with well-balanced, velvety tannins. It is very dry, with a pleasant acidulous note.

Winemaker Vintage Notes

2017: After the very good 2016 vintage, with its juicy, lively, and multilayered white wines and the promising, structured red wines, Alto Adige's wine industry is also more than satisfied with the 2017 vintage. The losses in terms of quantity of up to 20 percent and more may have left a bad taste in some mouths, but the quality of the wines is consistently good to very good. With the white wines, the vintage presents itself with somewhat leaner but very elegant, fresh and fruity, juicy wines with aromas that are typical to their varieties.

Winemaker Vinification Notes

Traditional maceration on the skins in temperature-controlled conditions in steel vats is followed by malolactic fermentation and ageing on fine lees in large wooden barrels.
