
CANTINA VALLE ISARCO SABIONA KERNER



Wine Introduction

The vineyards carpeting the steep slopes of the massive dioritic Sabiona rocks are located in one of the best winegrowing areas. The top-of-the-range Sabiona wines come from the Benedictine Monastery's well ventilated, sun-kissed vineyards. The limited production of 3,000 bottles are released after ageing on the lees for 10 months followed by one year in the bottle. The Kerner variety finds absolutely ideal growth conditions in the areas close to the top of the cultivation borders. The lean soil and the colder climate, featuring cold nights and abundant sunlight during the day, are the ingredients of this intensely flavoured and spicy wine.

Tasting Notes

This pale yellow wine displays an intense nose, with aromatic tendencies, and hints of apricot and peach. On the palate, this aromatic fruitiness is followed up with intense flavour and a spiciness balanced by a vivacious acidity.

Winemaker Vinification Notes

Delicate crushing after a short period of contact with the skins, controlled-temperature fermentation in stainless steel tanks, no malolactic fermentation, 10 months of lying on fine lees, followed by 1 year ageing in the bottle
