Wine Introduction

The composition of Apartado varies each year depending on the best barrels of the harvest. The Apartado story began in 1997, when the owner of the winery asked our head winemaker Mariano Di Paola why certain barrels were “set apart from the rest.” He was so impressed with the wines that he immediately asked Mariano to start producing a new line. Today, the Apartado range represents the true richness of the vineyards in the Uco Valley. It is truly a head turner, as it delicately combines the best Rutini has to offer.

Tasting Notes

An intense but silky red Malbec with purple undertones. On the nose is elegant, floral aromas blend with fruity notes. Complex mouthfeel, concentrated but smooth. Fruity and potent character with hints of liquorice and notes of toasty cocoa beans and coffee imparted by French oak.

Winemaker Vinification Notes

A Malbec created through careful grape selection in the best vineyards of Rutini: Altamira, La Consulta and Tupungato. This combination gives rise to the perfect expression of Malbec.
