Wine Introduction

The grapes of these wines are products of a careful selection of our finest vineyards in the Leyda Valley. They are harvested by hand, with yields averaging of 8-10 tons.

Tasting Notes

This Sauvignon Blanc has a pale yellow colour with some green hues. On the nose it is intense with aromas of grapefruit, pears and herbs. On the palate it is balanced, persistent and with great acidity.

Winemaker Vinification Notes

The grapes are harvested very early in the morning to maintain freshness, and alcoholic fermentation occurs at 14-15°C. When the alcoholic fermentation is finished, a part of the wine is left sur lies. After blending, the wine is clarified, cold stabilised, and filtered through fine earth. The wine is filtered again through a sterile plate and diaphragm to be sure that there is microbiological stability before bottling.
