Wine Introduction

La Bandina is a single vineyard Valpolicella Superiore. All the grapes from the vineyard are used to make La Bandina, none are taken to make Amarone, giving La Bandina the best possible quality grapes. It can be drunk upon release or aged for many years to come.

Tasting Notes

La Bandina is deep ruby red with purple nuances. On the nose the aroma is fruity and intense with hints of cherry, red fruit, liquorice, tobacco and cedar wood. On the palate the flavour is soft and warm, supported by a good structure, it is balanced and persistent.
