Wine Introduction

Vecchie Vigne is a single vineyard wine made using only grapes from the oldest vines (average of 40 years) in Monte Ceriani. Furthermore, Vecchie Vigne is aged in French oak for 6 months giving it additional complexity making this wine a must for any wine enthusiast.

Tasting Notes

Vecchie Vigne Soave is straw yellow with golden reflections. On the nose it has intense and complex aroma of, bitter almond, paraffin, flint, ripe white and yellow fruit, nuts and biscuit. On the palate it is warm, soft, savoury and slightly astringent with a long finish.
